The number of credits achieved and recognized by the program of study in this exam category are given in parentheses. ECTS credits are synonymous with achievement points (LP). The work requirements (attendance, independent study and exam preparation) for the individual modules are given achievement points. Generally, 1 achievement point is given per 30 hours of work. Students acquire achievement points when they successfully fulfill the module or course requirements.

“Grade”

Evaluating the achievement in accordance with the Partial Achievement Evaluation System. Numerical grades are provided in the original.

Miscellaneous:

Final assignments for a module which are not completed within the framework of a particular course are listed under “Final Module Exam(s)” for each module. Recognized achievements or courses are indicated and, if applicable, the name of the external university is provided.

Current GPA

Calculated in accordance with regulations for the weighting of the final grade point average within the framework of exam regulations and, if applicable, in accordance with the supplementary departmental regulations; the current GPA is based on all achievements to date. After successful completion of studies, the Current GPA constitutes the final grade.
