



Fellowship at the Zentralinstitut für Kunstgeschichte, Munich from 1st June 2025

Applications must be submitted between:

31st March -13th April 2025

The fellowship, which is financed according to the Hamburg Law for the Promotion of Young Scientists and Artists (HmbNFG), serves the purpose of further scientific education and the implementation of research projects in connection with a collaboration at the ZI in Munich. The fellowship is exclusively granted to art historians who are pursuing a doctorate or have completed a doctorate at the University of Hamburg.

Applications are decided upon by the University's Awards Committee in consultation with the Zentralinstitut für Kunstgeschichte in Munich.

- The funding period is at least one 1 year with the option of an extension for a further year.
- The fellowship amounts to 1.500 euros per month.
- Funding is available for research projects in connection with a collaboration at the ZI in Munich.
