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GENERAL INFORMATION

Aim of the Call:

- Facilitate the initiation and support the continuation of collaboration in research, teaching and administration, primarily with UHH's international strategic and profile partner universities. In exceptional cases, cooperation with other international partner universities may be eligible for funding if it serves the strategic objectives of the faculties.
- Foster activities at the partner university or in Hamburg that strengthen and deepen international partnership and aim at creating long-term and sustainable partnerships

General framework:

- Call for applications:
submission deadline 31 January 2025
- Start of funding is 1 March 2025.
Please note that "in-depth reviews" may delay the starting date of individual activities.
- Funding for successful applications is available until Dec 31st, 2025. Funds cannot be transferred to the next year.
- Grantees must submit a report including a relevant photo no more than six weeks after concluding the funded activities

FUNDING

Funding is only available for expenses as detailed below. Please use the financial plan template.

Outgoing:

- Travel expenses (economy), accommodation, and per diem expenses (according to [BRKG](#)), maximum IPF funding for travel expenses depends on location, see "[Eligible Partners and Expenditures for IPF](#)" information sheet.
- The duration of stay must be justified by the program and planned activities, maximum duration of stay is 12 days

Incoming:

- Costs for accommodation in Hamburg for a maximum of 12 days and a maximum of 130,00€ per night

Other:

- Coffee break or joint dinner/lunch with partners visiting Hamburg

As a general rule, funding can be requested for three researchers/staff, only in exceptional cases can additional people be included in the application.

* Visits of scientific conferences are not eligible for funding.



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be employed by Universität Hamburg as a researcher (Professor, Post-Doc, Academic Assistant) or as administrative staff
- Applications of early career researchers must have the support from professor or doctoral supervisor
- Impact on scholarly work, teaching and learning or intercultural exchange beyond the applicant's personal development
- One grant per person per year
- Strategic and profile partners eligible for funding are listed here ("[Eligible Partners and Expenditures for IPF](#)"). With some institutions, the Dept. of International Affairs publishes special joint calls, those partners are excluded from the IPF Call. See [Overview of Funding Programs](#) for any open calls.
- If of strategic importance for the faculty, other international partner universities are eligible for funding.

SELECTION REQUIREMENTS*

- Purpose of activity: Activity will establish or expand collaboration in research, teaching, or administration (network idea)
- Broad involvement of researchers: Other researchers/staff at UHH are involved in the cooperation and the partnership is not solely based on individual contacts.
- Seed-funding-character: initial funding (first- or second-time application with that partner/research group) or first application since 2019
- Other sources of funding: Other sources of funding for the activity have been explored (third party funding, other co-funding).
- Contribution to Sustainable Development Goals
- Attention to diversity aspects
- Visibility of the activity (dissemination)

* your application will be evaluated by the Dept. of International Affairs based on the criteria above.

The Department of International Affairs greatly encourages sustainability and sustainable development. All applications with institutions that are not eligible strategic partners or profile partner institutions should demonstrate a clear reference to at least one of the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
